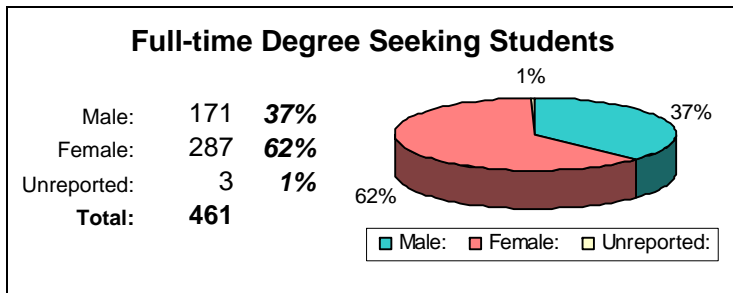

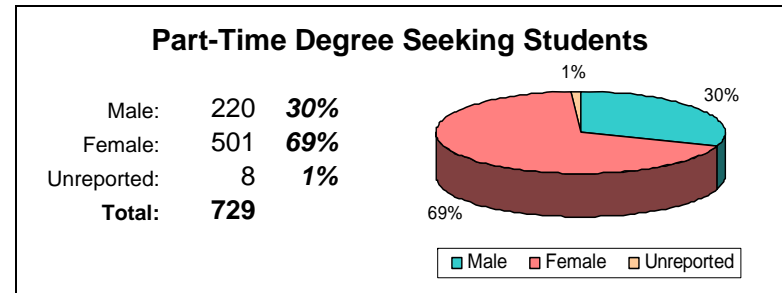

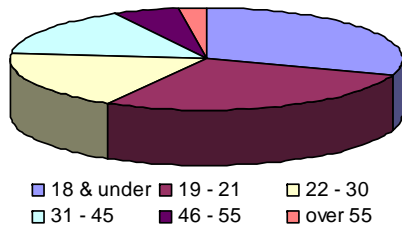
FTE (Full-Time Equivalent) is a method of funding and accountability defined by the State Department of Education. For all courses the number of student semester hours is divided by 30.

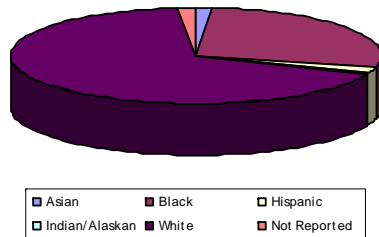
