		Results of assessment activities:	22 students met the requirements to enter the Fall 2005 PCT program 20 students completed the program ( 90% completed) 17 students entered the Spring 2006 PCT program.	
2.)	80% of the Fall program completers will pass the State certification examination within one year of program completion. 80% of the Spring program completers will pass the State certification exam.	Means of assessment and criteria for success:	State reporting will allow the Allied Health Department track the pass/fail rate of the program completers on the State Exam.	Spring class is ongoing.
		Results of assessment activities:	16 of the 20 Fall completers have taken the state exam. = 80% 14 of the 16 Fall completers who took the exam, passed on 1st attempt = 87.5%	
3.)	90% of program completers with passing scores on the State Certification Exam will be employed in the patient care field within one year of program completion.	Means of assessment and criteria for success:	The annual Alumni Survey conducted by NFCC will indicate the number of completers who are employed in the field within a year of program ending.	Spring class is ongoing and will be measured at a later date.
		Results of assessment activities:	Of the 20 students who completed the program, 10 have gained employment in the field. = 50%

The annual Alumni Survey will be the tool used to determine how satisfied program completers were with the training they received while a PCT student.	Due to some suggestions made by the 2004-2005 PCT Classes, the 2005-2006 PCT Classes are doing 2- 12 hour clinicals a week instead of 3- 8 hour clinicals.
		Results of assessment activities:	The Employer survey indicated a high rate of satisfaction with the program completers.
