


## ***NFCC Library – FINDING FULL TEXT ARTICLES***

- Go to the library to get an NFCC student ID with a barcode on it. Have your barcode activated.
- Access the library's home page: **www.nfcc.edu/library**.
- Click on ***Find Journal and Magazine Articles***.
- Select **North Florida Community College** from the drop-down list.
- Enter your barcode number from your student ID card as your borrower ID.
- Enter your PIN (last four digits of your Social Security Number).
