Admissions

Each Applicant:

1. Must be at least 18 years of age and have a high school diploma or have passed the GED.
2. Must complete and return a NFCC application for admission to the EMS Department with a \$20.00 application fee.
3. Must complete and return an EMT-Basic Application to the EMS Department that must include:
 - Completed Medical Clearance form
 - Copy of GED or High School Diploma
 - Proof of Florida residency
 - Complete Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) with passing scores.
 - Immunization Records
 - Background Check (\$60 fingerprinting fee)

NFCC Emergency Medical Technician Basic

(11 College Credit Hours)

One Semester Certificate Program



The Basic Emergency Medical Technician program at North Florida Community College was developed to provide first-phase training in the career ladder of the emergency medical technician.

To be employed with an ambulance service in the State of Florida, a student must be trained and certified through the EMS section of the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services. Successful completion of this course will enable the student to apply to take the State Examination for EMTs.

The program is four months (one semester) in duration and requires 330 clock hours.

Evening and daytime class schedules are available. Additional clinical runs will be scheduled by the instructor.

PROGRAM COST:

Total cost of the four-month program is approximately \$1500. This cost includes tuition, books, Emergency Vehicle Operations Course, supplies and a one time NFCC application fee.*

PROGRAM MODULES:

At the end of each Module, the student will demonstrate the following performance standards.

- Module I:** The basic responsibilities of the EMT-Basic
- Module II:** Airway Management, Ventilation and Oxygen Therapy.
- Module III:** Interviewing, documentation and recording patient findings.
- Module IV:** Recognize medical emergencies, illnesses and disease processes, Obstetrical emergencies and infection control.
- Module V:** Treatment of traumatic injuries, Recognize situations of risk during a rescue operation.
- Module VI:** Recognize the difference in treatment that infants and children require.
- Module VII:** Safe handling of patients, proper ambulance operations, safe access and extrication, how to triage and treat victims of a Mass Casualty Incident and how to recognize and handle a victim of a hazardous material accident.
- Module VIII:** Understand the anatomy and procedures that the EMT-Basic may be exposed to in emergency settings.
