## Admissions

### Each Applicant:

1. Must be at least 18 years of age and have a high school diploma or have passed the GED.
2. Must complete and return a NFCC application for admission to the NFCC Admissions Department, Bldg 3, with a \$20.00 application fee.
3. Must complete and return an EMS Application to the Career & Technical Education Center, EMS Dept., Bldg 13.

### Paramedic Applications MUST INCLUDE:

1. The completed applications.
2. Completed Medical Clearance form.
3. Copy of GED or High School Diploma.
4. Proof of Florida residency.
5. Satisfactory CPT scores.
6. Documentation of current CPR certification.
7. Immunization Records
8. Background Check
9. Documentation of EMT-B license
10. Documentation of completed A&P requirement or registered for A&P in 1st semester of program.
11. 3 letters of reference from past employers.
12. Copy of Birth Certificate.

## 11 Month Certificate Program

The Paramedic program at North Florida Community College was developed to fulfill the requirements to practice, under medical direction, the art and science of out-of-hospital medicine. The goal of the program is to provide the graduate with the knowledge, skill and professional attributes associated with an entry-level Paramedic. Graduates are trained to prevent and reduce mortality and morbidity due to illness and injury.

Successful completion of this course will enable the student to apply to take the State Registry Examination for Paramedics.

The program is 11 months in duration and requires 38 credit hours. A four (4) hour Anatomy and Physiology course is required for the program. Classes meet 9 a.m.-4 p.m.

## APPLICATION DEADLINES:

Applications are accepted throughout the year for classes beginning in January. Applicants are notified of placement in the program when all admission criteria have

## PROGRAM COST:

## ADMISSION POLICIES:

Selection is based upon the following:

1. Completed CPR Course for BLS Health Care Providers. A copy of your current card should be attached to your application.
2. Completed Application for admission to North Florida Community College.
3. Completed application to the Paramedic program. Because space in the program is limited, applications are dated when they are received by the department. The date the COMPLETED APPLICATION PACKET is received may be used in the selection process.
4. CPT Scores.
5. Attendance at orientation session
6. Documentation of State of Florida EMT-B certification.
7. Letter of recommendation from the EMS Director or Fire Chief.
