[DISPLACED HOMEMAKER PROGRAM

The Displaced Homemaker Program at North Florida Community College is for people who are at least 35 years of age, homemakers and have experienced a major life changing event.

YOU MAY QUALIFY IF...

- You are 35 years of age or older
- Have worked in the home providing unpaid services for family members
- Are not adequately employed
- Have had difficulty securing adequate employment
- Have been dependent of the income of another family member but no longer receive that income or have been dependent on federal assistance
